#### HELP WANTED - INTAKE PERSONS

Volunteers are needed to work in the SVdP Guest Intake ministry. Prospective guests call in on our Hot Line phone and leave messages outlining their needs. You monitor messages left on the Hot Line Voice Mail several times during your shift from the comfort of your home and do call backs to the prospective guests to gather more specific information and to then fill out an intake form. There are detailed procedures for this work and training will be provided. Requires clerical level computer skills. Please remember, all of this can be done from your home on a schedule of your convenience. **Please pray on this and join us at our General Meeting Tuesday June 20 at 6:30PM in the Narthex.** You will have an opportunity to talk to Intake Persons to answer questions regarding your participation in the Vincentian ministry.
