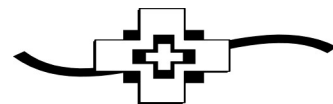

St. Vincent de Paul Society

The FoodBank of Monmouth and Ocean Counties provides emergency food from its Neptune warehouse to 131,000 Monmouth and Ocean County residents - 1 in 10 people - including close to 40,000 children through 300 partner agencies (like St. Luke). The FoodBank will now also be operating at the B.E.A.T Center, 1769 Hooper Ave. Toms River, where it will also operate a Jon Bon Jovi Soul Kitchen and the Peoples Pantry to continue the mission to alleviate hunger and build food security in Monmouth and Ocean Counties. Their goal is to feed the food lines while working to shorten them.

In May 2016, the St. Luke Conference Food Pantry gave 666 Bags of Food to 113 Families consisting of 192 Adults and 51 Children.
