Pope Francis has proclaimed "A Holy Year of Mercy" which commenced on December 8, 2015 through November 20, 2016. The Motto for this Holy Year is "Merciful like the Father" and it is intended to 'serve as an invitation to follow the merciful example of the Father who asks us not to judge or condemn but to forgive and to give love and forgiveness without measure."

## Quote of the Week:

"...the pardon of which St. Francis made himself a 'channel' here at the Porzincola continues to 'bring forth heaven' even after eight centuries. In this Holy Year of Mercy, it becomes ever clearer that the path of forgiveness can truly renew the Church and the world. The world needs forgiveness; too many people are caught up in resentment and harbor hatred, because they are incapable of forgiving.
