

A Letter from Deacon Lou

January 2018

My dear fellow parishioners,

I was ordained a deacon in the Trenton Diocese on May 14, 1994. My first assignment was at St. Justin Martyr Parish. I transferred to St. Luke Parish in May 2001. As most of you know, I have had Parkinson's for the past ten years. My symptoms have worsened and new ones presented themselves to the point that it has become very difficult to continue to carry out my duties as a deacon. Therefore, it is with a heavy heart that I must write this letter to announce my retirement as of February 1, 2018. My last assigned Mass is at 12:00 pm on Sunday, January 28th.

I am grateful to the late Fr. Lou Kralovich for welcoming me into St. Luke Parish in 2001. I thank Fr. Bob, our pastor, for his continued support over the past several years. I want to thank Deacon Joe DeMaria and Deacon Bob Pladek who made every effort to make things easier for me during the last couple of years. I thank all of our altar servers. They have been a very big help for me.

Although there is no monetary compensation for deacons, the rewards I have received are priceless and more than I could have imagined. I married all of my children, baptized all of my grandchildren, gave most of them their First Holy Communion and assisted at my mother's Funeral Mass. I have had the privilege of doing this for other family members and friends as well. I feel the greatest privilege has been to stand within feet of the altar during the Consecration, when the celebrant miraculously changes simple bread and wine into the Precious Body and Blood of Christ.

I thank you for your friendship, your love and support, your kind words, handshakes, hugs and for laughing at my jokes over the years. I am not going anywhere; but, instead of being up at the altar during Mass, I will be in the pew with my wife, Sharyn, sitting next to you. I look forward to your continued handshakes and hugs; and know for sure, I will have many more jokes to tell. I will continue to be the Spiritual Director for the Prayer Shawl Ministry and the Rosary Altar Society, and perhaps something else every now and then.

Thank you for allowing me to serve God and you here at St. Luke's. It has been my sincere joy and honor. Please keep me in your prayers as I will continue to pray for you. Thank you and may God bless you.
